Subject: Information Technology Consultant Services- FOR APPROVAL

Purpose of Report

The purpose of this report is to seek approval from the Management committee to conduct a tendering exercise to appoint an appropriate external IT (Information Technology) consultant from February 2020.

Tender Exercise

The Association seeks an expert in Information Communication Technology (ICT) who will assist us to explore our options, identify our business needs and develop an ICT Strategy. The Association wishes to embrace digital transformation and other innovative solutions.

The intended outcome of the process is to provide assurance to the Management Committee that the association has sound business systems and that the association is effectively managing its ICT activities.

We require the successful bidder to appraise the Business System which is currently supplied by Castleton PLC. Our current support and maintenance contract ends on 10/02/2021 and the Association has not yet decided to upgrade to the latest version of Kypera Hometeam. The Kypera Hometeam business software supports our Housing Management, Property Services and Factoring activities. The Association upgraded to the latest version of Kypera Financials in 2018.

IT Consultancy Services/Providers

The Association approached GWSF to gain insight into experience gained from other Housing Associations and a circular was issued to all members. Several Association's responded with positive comments.

Based on the recommendations received from other forum member's the Association contacted the relevant firms to enquire if they would be interested in tendering for the work. The following consultancy firms confirmed an expression of interest:
